

Free Tax Return Prep

To get your refund, child tax credit, earned income tax credit, or missing stimulus money, **you must file a tax return!**

If you live in DC and make \$74,000 or less, these places can help you prepare your federal and state taxes *for free*. Most require an appointment, so call them soon!

What should I bring to my appointment?

- Photo ID (for self and spouse if a joint return),
- Social Security card or other documents confirming your Social Security Number or ITIN (for you and your dependents),
- Income and tax documents (e.g., W2s, 1099s),
- Tax correspondence received from the IRS or DC
- Prior year return if you have it, and
- Bank account information to sign up for direct deposit of your refund

When you make your appointment, you will get a detailed list of anything else you need to bring with you.
